The Talbot County Board of Education met in a voting work session on June 1, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mr. Anton Turner (D1), Mr. James Steverson, Vice Chair (D2), Mrs. Sharleta Hall, Chairperson (D3), and Mrs. Mildred Biggs (D5). Mr. Carlton Mahone (D4) was absent.

- The meeting was called to order by Chair Sharleta Hall at 6:00 p.m.
- Chair Sharleta Hall led the Moment of Silence.
- Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chair Sharleta Hall.
- A motion was made by Mr. James Steverson to approve the June 1, 2021 agenda seconded by Mrs. Mildred Biggs. 4-0-0
- Action Items from Superintendent
Mrs. Cynthia Epps, Assistant Superintendent
- Mrs. Epps presented Dylan Leverett with his high school diploma. Mr. Leverett has enlisted in the United States Navy as a Hospital Corpman Advanced Technical field. He was reporting to basic prior to Central High School's graduation. Mr. Taylor announced to Mrs. Epps that Dylan Joseph Leverett has completed all of the requirements in order to graduate. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian is announced after the third nine weeks. Students must have an 85 average to be considered an honor graduate.



- Mr. James Steverson made a motion to approve the Bus Request, seconded by Mrs. Mildred Biggs. 4-0-0


- GSBA Summer Conference – Ms. Andrews – provided the board with their travel packets and conference information for their trip to Savannah, GA.
