


The Talbot County Board of Education met in work session on September 1, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mrs. Quintella Carter (D1), Mr. James Steverson (D2), Mrs. Sharleta Hall, Chairperson (D3), Mr. Carlton Mahone (D4) and Mr. Harrison Couch (D5).

- The meeting was called to order by Chair Sharleta Hall at 6:00 p.m.
- Chair Sharleta Hall led the Moment of Silence.
- Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chair Sharleta Hall.
- A motion was made by Mr. James Steverson to approve the September 1, 2020 agenda seconded by Mr. Carlton Mahone. 5-0-0
- Action Items from Superintendent

- Covid-19 Update – Mrs. Walker – Talbot County has 154 confirmed cases. Seven new cases have been reported this week. All surrounding counties are steadily increasing.
- Threat Level Determination – Mrs. Epps – The level for Talbot County is at medium to medium high level.
- Training Agenda – The Talbot County School Board will meet September 2nd through September 4, 2020 for their annual retreat. The board agreed to hold the retreat at the school this year due to the Covid19 threat.
- Start of School – Mrs. Walker – Teachers are arriving two days early in order to train on the Microsoft 365 system used to provide at-home learning to the students that chose this. Classrooms are setup to provide social distancing for the students that will be in-person.
- Enrollment numbers – Mrs. Walker – approximately one-third of the students will be attending school in person. Students have until Friday, September 18, 2020 to make their final decision to attend school in-person or to be an at-home learner.
- Central High School's first football game will be Friday, September 4, 2020. GHSA rules for social distancing will be followed. The price for admittance to the game is \$7.00 all other away games will be \$10.

- Construction Update – The striping on the field has been completed. Waiting on more love grass to be planted.
