Plan Ahead for Test Success

A little planning can make preparing for test more effective. Before a test, have your child ask and answer these questions:

- ⚡ How well do I know each topic?
- ⚡ Do I need time to learn as well as review?
- ⚡ What Strategies will I use to study (self-test, flash cards, etc.)?
